Workshop Information

Workshops generally run from 9 am to 6:30 pm with a mid-day break for lunch, beach time and/or free studio work time. Lunch is not provided but nearby dining options range from, an on-site deli, to various bar/restaurants within walking distance, as well as a small local grocery. We provide a continental breakfast to get you started, and coffee, tea, and water are provided throughout the day.

Please note, Maho Bay Clay Works holds intimate, small group workshops with maximum student participation of 10. To make sure a spot is reserved for you please register early. SPACE IS LIMITED.

Deposit & Registration

To register for our workshops and confirm your seat please submit the registration form and 50% deposit. Deposits can be paid in advance by credit card, check or money order. Workshop registration will be confirmed by email and is not guaranteed until deposit is received. Remaining balance for workshops will be paid on the start date.

By submitting a signed registration form you are agreeing to the content listed on this page and authorizing Maho Bay Clay Works to charge your credit card for workshop deposit.

Cancellation Policy

Because of our obligations to our instructors and shipping of materials from the mainland, no refund of any deposit or payment will be made for cancellations within 60 days of the start of the workshop unless the studio rebooks your space.

If cancellations are made prior to the 60 day limit we will refund any deposit or fee paid less an \$85 handling fee.

We reserve the right to cancel a workshop if minimum enrollments are not met, in which case any deposits or fees paid will be refunded 100%. Notification to participants will be made at least 59 days prior to the start of the workshop. Although this is uncommon due to our small class sizes.

Please note, Maho Bay Clay Works cannot be responsible for travel costs, flight delays, lack of accommodations and/or accommodation expenses. Because of this strict policy, we ask you to obtain travelers insurance to prevent loss from unforeseen events that will change your plans.
